

Carrington Hotel

Verification and Validation Report

The famous Carrington Hotel in Katoomba required further onsite parking for their patrons.

A basement and the first-level car park were established on the southern side, a small area between the library and the Carrington Hotel gardens. It was the site of the former house site, which the heritage advisors documented.

CESsoils was commissioned to verify the transport and quality of soils to be reused under the Resource Recovery.

We supplied a virgin excavated natural material (VENM) certificate after investigating the geology and ensuring that the stockpile site was appropriately secure, and that part of the transport record was documented.

The soils were to be reused at the Katoomba aerodrome.

The material had fine quartz sandstone, which made it particularly interesting as our clients did the mapping.

The outcome was that client was compliant with the Waste Regulation and the Waste Avoidance Act.
